Applicants/ nominators are asked to detail their/ their nominees contributions to marine conservation and the development of public awareness of marine conservation in Aotearoa. Applicants/ nominators are also asked to explain any current projects they are working on and how \$1000 could go towards their project or further study. In addition to a potential \$1000 contribution prize, the recipient will receive a Wettie wetsuit, free registration to the Mountains to Sea Conservation Trust Annual Wānanga (travel costs can be funded for recipient), a trip to the Poor Knights Islands with Dive!
